Monty L. DeVaney, 74, of Waterville, WA died Thursday evening, Sept. 27, 2012. He was born March 10, 1938 in Twin Falls, ID. He moved with his family to Waterville, in 1946 where he attended School. After graduating from High School in 1956, he enlisted in the US Army. After his honorable discharge in 1959 he moved to Alaska where he worked as a surveyor for the US Forest Service and the State of Alaska. He married Agatha Savage in 1961 and she preceded him in death in 1972. He began commercial fishing in 1966 and in the winter he worked for the Alaska Highway Dept. in the Valdez district plowing snow.

Monty was an avid outdoorsman, hunter and fisherman. He married Carolyn Callen in 1975 and in 1976 returned to Waterville where he resided until his death. During his retirement years he became a master gardener, raised; and trained Labrador hunting dogs, participated in field trail and spent many hours in the field hunting, fishing and hiking.

He is survived by his wife, Carolyn DeVaney of Waterville, Daughter and son in law, Linda and Mike Burke of Waterville, Mother, Dorothy DeVaney of Wenatchee, brother, Stan DeVaney and sister, Helen Mires, both of Waterville and numerous grandchildren and great grand children.
