



## Otilie "Tillie" S Magnotti

May 23, 1927 - December 11, 2014

Our Mom, Oma, Oma-ma, Aunt, Sister, and Friend, Otilie Magnotti, left her earthly body at home, at the age of 87, on December 11, 2014, surrounded by loving family. Otilie was born to Otto H. Siegrist and Anna Baier Siegrist on May 23, 1927, in Berkach, Germany. She was honored to be naturalized as a United States citizen in 1949. Otilie's childhood and early to mid-adulthood were spent in New Jersey. However, after a visit, she fell in love with the Wenatchee Valley and moved here with her family in 1976.
