March 31, 1919 - April 26, 2015

Pauline A. (Evans) Guthrie passed away April 26 at the age of 96. She was born March 31, 1919 in Molene, Kansas, the eldest of three daughters. She lived in Molene until her marriage to Cleo Evans in 1936 and thereafter made her home with Cleo in Clifty, Arkansas. She had three children: Barbara, Sharon and Michael. During that time she also ran the kitchen at the Blueberry Hills Farm Restaurant in Clifty, drawing diners from nearby cities like Oklahoma City, Tulsa, Dallas and Kansas City. The restaurant received great reviews from many magazines.

After 46 years of marriage, Cleo died in 1982. She married Ernest Guthrie on August 26, 1987 and made her home in Cashmere, Washington where for nearly 28 years they enjoyed many fishing trips, gardening and making yard crafts. They both enjoyed entering their bountiful produce in the Chelan County Fair and won many awards.

Pauline was preceded in death by her first husband, Cleo; her sister, Mildred McCoy of Springdale, Arkansas; her stepdaughter, Oneita (Guthrie) Owenby. She is survived by her sister, Dolly Higby; her children, Barbara (Ed) Brown, Sharon (Garland) Bryant, Michael Evans; and stepchildren, Ernest Jr. (Kathy) Guthrie, Jim Guthrie, and D'Lynn (Aaron) Davis, as well as numerous grandchildren, great-grandchildren, great-great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews and many good friends.
