Randy J. Brandt, age 67, passed away on Sunday September 17th, 2017 in Wenatchee Wa.

This elk camp is not only one of the oldest standing camps on the mountain, but now holds two generations of men including Randy's sons. Randy also loved to travel. His adventures with Terri took him many places,

but his favorite was watching sunsets in Mazatlan. His passion for life continued in his love for Seahawks football. Not a home game passed without Randy donning his favorite Jersey, heading to the city, and having "a dog" and a bowl of chowder at the stadium before the game. From grilling oysters to perfection at the lake each summer to watching each Seahawks game to the end, Randy will be remembered as a passionate man who ALWAYS finished what he started.
