Randall C. Polson joined Jesus Christ and other loved ones in Heaven on January 28, 2011. He was born November 11, 1925 to Hans and Martha (Jensen) Polson at the family home north of Waterville. He graduated from Waterville High School in 1943. He then spent 2 years in the Army Air Force during World War II. After the Air Force he went to the University of Oregon graduating with a Bachelor's degree. During his studies at the University of Oregon he met and married Barbara Link in 1949 and they had 5 children. After graduation they moved to California where he went to the College of Physicians and Surgeons now known as the University of Pacific in San Francisco graduating with a degree in Dentistry. He practiced dentistry in San Carlos, Lake Tahoe and Santa Rosa where they later retired. Randall lost his wife Barbara of 51 years to cancer in 2000.

In 2007 he was reacquainted with his former classmate & friend Helena Wilson Fuller. They were married on January 26th 2008 and resided in Puyallup. They spent many long visits to his home in California and weeklong visits to Waterville several times a year.
