



Richard "Dick" Foss

Dick was born the youngest of three sons to Leif and Grace Foss in St. Paul, Minnesota. He grew up, attended schools and graduated from Johnson High School. One of his favorite memories was of his dog, Boots, his trusted companion for 18 years.

Dick earned his pilots license before he got his drivers license, so it was no surprise to anyone when he enlisted in the Air Force in 1948 and was honorably discharged in 1952.

Dick attended the University of Minnesota and Macalister College focusing on Business Administration and eventually made his career as a corporate auditor for 45 years. He was very involved with Toastmasters International and the Institute of Internal Auditors.

Dick married Guenivere G. Graupman, September 1960, at First Lutheran Church in Glencoe, MN. They were life partners for 53 years, until Guen's death. Dick and Guen moved to the Wenatchee Valley upon their retirement from San Francisco, CA. They were actively involved in the Wenatchee Valley Senior Center and members of Grace Lutheran church.

Dick is preceded in death by Guen, his parents and his brothers; Pastor Kenneth Foss and Robert Foss. He is survived by several nieces and nephews.
