



Robert "Bob" Gruenberg

October 31, 1947 - December 17, 2024

Robert Raymond (Bob) Gruenberg passed away on December 17, 2024 from complications of non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma and pneumonia. His family and beloved grandchildren were by his side.

Bob was born in Wenatchee, WA on October 31, 1947, Halloween, his favorite holiday. He was raised on the family apple orchard on Washington Street in Manson. He graduated from Manson High School in 1967. After some college, he joined the United States Army from April 1969 to April 1971. He met his wife Sandi Marshall of Chelan in 1968. They were married in Chelan on August 4, 1973 and celebrated 51 wonderful years together.

Bob worked as a custodian for the Lake Chelan School District for 28 years. He coached Middle School fastpitch softball and helped with his daughter Pam's softball program. In April of 2020, Bob and Sandi moved to East Wenatchee. In May of 2022, Bob was diagnosed with non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma. He went through two rounds of chemotherapy and started the third when he became too weak to continue.

Bob was preceded in death by his parents, Earl and Dorothy (Munch) Gruenberg; sister, Patricia Wood, and several aunts and uncles.

He is survived by his wife Sandi who he lived with in East Wenatchee,

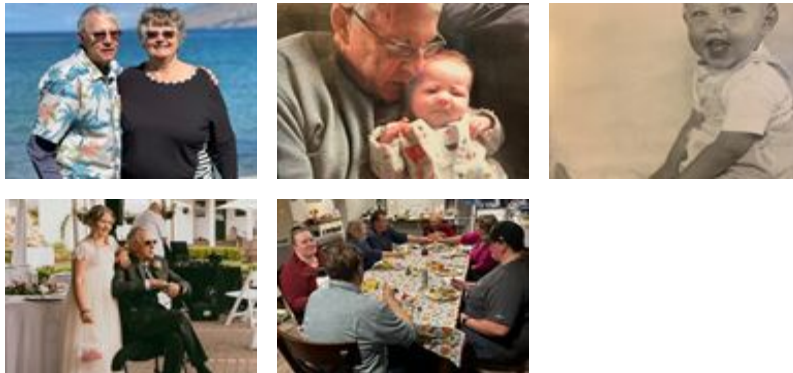
