Roberta F. Lowers went home to be with the Lord on Tues., Nov. 8, 2016 after a short battle with cancer. She was born in Seattle on April 29, 1929 to James H. and Roberta R. Frink. "Buddy" attended high school at Helen Bush High School in Seattle and attended college at Washington State College in Pullman where she was a member of Alpha Gamma Delta sorority. It was at college she met the love of her life and husband of 66 years, Herb Lowers. They were married on Aug. 12, 1950 at the Church of the Epiphany in Seattle. Buddy and Herb made their home in Cashmere, WA and raised 4 children – Scott, Mike (Shelley), Susie (John), and Janet (Tim). In the years to follow, they were blessed with 10 grandchildren and 24 great grandchildren, who were all the pride and joy of her life.
