Roberta Moody, 93, longtime resident of Cashmere, WA, died on Saturday evening, June 2, 2012, at home. She was born on July 16, 1918, in Santa Rosa, CA to Temple and Florence Smith. She spent most of her childhood in Santa Rosa and Sonoma. She married D. Gordon Moody on May 18, 1940, in Reno, NV. In 1941, they moved to Cashmere and purchased an apple orchard. Here they raised their four daughters, Anne McClendon, Thayer (Keith) Baines, Susan (Randy) Webb, and Damaris (Don) Wight. Bobbie, as she was known to all of her friends, was active in the Cashmere PTA, League of Women Voters and Campfire Girls. She volunteered for Habitat for Humanity and taught ESL to immigrant students. Her interests included bridge and other card games, books, music, and the New York Times Crossword Puzzles. Additionally, she travelled to Europe and Asia, enjoying the experience of other cultures. She also welcomed into her home exchange students and other foreign visitors. Other pursuits that brought her pleasure were knitting, sewing, needlepoint and painting.

She was preceded in death by her husband; and brother, Temple Smith. She is survived by her sisters, Thayer Horn and Sydney Newell; her four

daughters; 11 grandchildren; and 10 great-grandchildren.
