Robin Michael Force was born in Mount Vernon, NY on May 5, 1941 to Robert and Dorothy Force. Rob entered the US Navy at age 17 and was honorably discharged after service during the Vietnam War. Following his service, Rob went to college where he met and then married his wife Shirley in 1968. After college Rob and Shirley moved to San Diego where Rob graduated from University of San Diego Law School in 1973. After graduating law school, Rob and Shirley moved to Seattle, where Rob began his legal career. While in Seattle, Rob and Shirley welcomed their first child, David in 1974. Rob then took the position as Deputy Prosecuting Attorney in Cowlitz County, moving the family to Longview, WA.
