Ronald Reed Anderson, Chef/Owner/Chocolatier of Lake Chelan Toffee & Truffle and resident of Wenatchee passed away on Friday, August 18, 2017 in the Central Washington Hospital after a tubing accident on the Wenatchee River in Cashmere. Ron was a lifelong fisherman, kayaker, hiker, guitar player, writer of fiction, and lover of life. He had a passion for the culinary arts, particularly for barbeque and all things chocolate. He delighted in serving friends his signature English Toffee and designing truffles for special events or for pairing with wine, cider and craft beer. Ron formerly resided in Marysville, WA and worked for Boeing Commercial Airplanes in Nonconformance Investigations for the 777/777X Wing Body Join 2007 through 2017. Prior to aerospace work he was a chef for The Keg and the Tulalip Casino as well as other restaurants in the Seattle area, worked briefly in radio in Idaho and Utah, worked in corrections facilities, and developed his scientific interest while working for Phillips Medical which led him to pursue degrees from the Oregon Institute of Technology and Everett Community College. He proudly served his country in the USMC in Iraq then worked as Embassy Security in Tel-Aviv and Somalia. He was a graduate of Meadowdale HS in Lynnwood, WA.

Ron is survived by his loving partner, Christine C. Wineberg, Psy.D. of Wenatchee, WA and their adventurous Westie, Jack. He is also survived by his half sister, Laurie A. Anderson of Fargo, ND, his paternal uncle, Keith J. Anderson of San Anselmo, CA and other extended family as well as
