



## Russell W. Haywood

June 28, 1946 - November 9, 2023

Russell was born in Seattle, Washington to William and Phyllis Haywood. The first few years of his life were spent moving to different areas due to father's job. His father was a certified welder, that was asked to work on the dams up and down the Columbia River.

In 1954 the family permanently moved to East Wenatchee. There Russell attended school at the Eastmont School District where he graduated in 1964. He also attended the Wenatchee Valley Community College.

Russell eventually went to work at the Alcoa Aluminum works for 18 years. He later decided to leave the Wenatchee area and moved to Seattle where he worked in the housing industry.

Russell was a lover of country music and West Coast dancing. He eventually got together with his dancing partner, Rosalia and would regularly dance around the Seattle area, but also traveled in the Pacific Northwest to dance in tournaments. Russell also enjoyed teaching West Coast dancing to others.

In 2020 Russell moved back to Wenatchee, so his family could assist him after being diagnosed with Parkinson's, which he succumbed to on November 9, 2023.

Russell leaves behind a daughter, Talia Haywood (Seattle), a son, Doug Haywood (Milwaukee, WI), 2 sisters, Sue Doll (East Wenatchee), Carla Cook (Wenatchee), 3 brothers, Randy Haywood (Wenatchee), William Haywood (Seattle) and Reg Haywood (Libby, MT) and several grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Interment is at the City of Wenatchee Cemetery.
