Sharon carried deeply, and as a mother was always involved in her daughters' activities, from serving as a BlueBird and CampFire leader to coaching their softball teams. 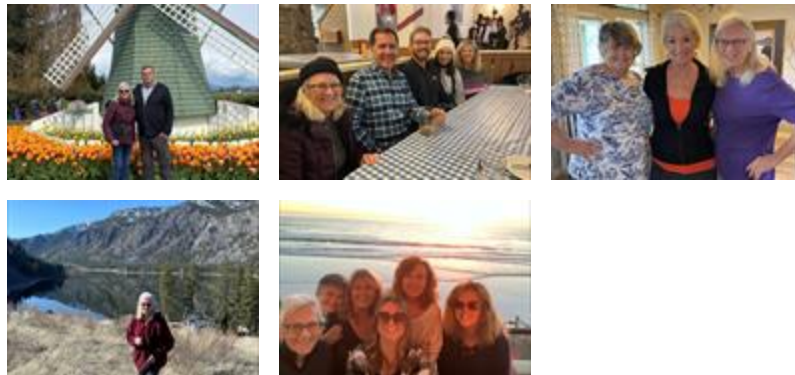
