Sharon went to be with our Lord Thursday morning as the sun rose over the mountain and filled the room with warmth and Peace. Her daughter Tami lay and cradled her in her arms while her devoted grandson Brad Jordan stood at her side until God took her to Heaven and she received her Glory day.

Sharon was an amazing woman, an excellent student, loved to write, and was always there to help tutor, listen, or give a hand up to many people that naturally gravitated to her. She was invited to the "Oprah show" to talk about depression. She pursued a tip from a TV program on dyslexia, which led the Wenatchee School district to send a teacher to learn how to teach these children. She was a member of the Burlington Northern Ladies club and had a column in their newspaper, "Shari's Bleeding Heart". A stay at home mom till her children were grown, she then bought "Siroco's Greek Restaurant" in Wenatchee and started the first salad bar in town, and made everything from scratch, including cuts of meat off the hook and making every bread roll and bun, including those famous butterhorns. Later she and her husband ran the Chelan County PUD cafeteria, and the Rocky Reach Dam visitors' center cafe and gift shop, meeting people from all over the world. She then ran a

restaurant and bar in Entiat until retiring. In her later years she lived with her daughter and son-in-law and enjoyed being a part of their family. She developed many health issues and was cared for by her daughter and her family until her passing.

She is survived by three children, Michael W. Hart, Edward L. Hart and Tamara R. Jordan (Steve), step-child Jeff Render, sister Virginia Rhoads, and brother Paul Sears (Royce). She left behind grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces and nephews, and many "adopted" children. She was preceded in death by her parents Glen and Laretta Sears, first husband Edward W. Hart, an infant grandchild, sister Gale Baird and brothers, Clinton, Bruce, Glen and Jack Sears, and step-children Clouie Greenway, Carol Elmer, and Johnny Render.

A memorial will be held on August 30th, 11AM at Jones & Jones – Betts Memorial Chapel in Wenatchee. Interment will be held immediately following at Wenatchee City Cemetery, she will rest beside her loving parents and several family members. A celebration of her life will follow at her second home in Palisades.
