August 9, 1950 - December 1, 2015

Sidney Alan Jordan, 65, of Palisades died Tuesday, December 1, 2015 at the University of Washington Hospital in Seattle following complications from his treatment of leukemia. Sid was born to Herman & Glenys (Peterson) Jordan on August 9, 1950 at the Douglas County Hospital in Waterville, WA. He grew up on the family farm near Withrow, graduated from Waterville High School in 1968, and attended Spokane Community College & Wenatchee Valley College. He was drafted by the Army and served in Vietnam. After the Army, Sid moved to Palisades to raise alfalfa & cattle with his father, and he eventually took over the family farm. Sid married Deborah Boldt in 1980.

Sid is survived by his three sons and their wives: Jason & Brandy Jordan of Rising Star, TX; Travis & Laura Jordan of Pasco, WA; Adam & Nicole Jordan of Bellingham, WA; and his two precious grandchildren: 20 month old Penelope of Pasco, WA and one year old McKavett of Rising Star, TX.

Sid's is also survived by his five sisters & their husbands: Kara (Phil) Rock, Kathie (Lavern) Blackburn, Bonnie (Rod) Sanderson, Debra (Tom) Rusnak and Laurel (Jerry) Morton; three aunts; many cousins, nieces, nephews, grandnieces & grandnephews; and his Palisades Community family.

A graveside service will be held in the Veteran's section at Evergreen Cemetery in East Wenatchee on Tuesday, December 15th at 11:00am. A
