She spent the next 33 years working in various departments, including data processing, the business office, IT, business intelligence, and accountable care. She was primarily in supervisory roles with staff sizes up to 30 people. Her hard work, organization, dedication, and proficiency resulted in success in all roles.

During her time at Confluence, her family continued to grow. She was blessed with her second daughter, Sara in 1993. She married Bruce in 1999, and in 2000, they all welcomed their granddaughter, Brenda’s daughter, Clara. She was extremely proud of the successful grown women the girls became.
