Sondra Kaye (Stockwell) Oneal, 69, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, daughter, sister and friend passed away Wednesday, Mar 20, 2013 in Seattle after bravely battling chronic illness for many years.

In August 1943, she was born to Vernon and Clara Stockwell in Seattle. Not long after, the family moved to the Wenatchee area where Son grew up and went to school, graduating from Wenatchee High School, class of 1961.

Over the years she held several positions in the work force, including as a realtor for Windermere Realty. But to her, the most important role of all was that that of wife and mother, which she executed with her best.

She is survived by her loving husband, Roger Oneal; three children: Tara Ohme of Seattle, Todd Erickson (Stacey) of East Wenatchee, and Kristen Cormick (Larry) of Monroe; her treasured mother, Clara Stockwell of Wenatchee; one brother, Douglas Stockwell of Wenatchee; one sister Barbara (Travis) Burney of Sedro Woolley; her much adored and cherished grandchildren: Sarah Ohme, Quinn and Lauryn Erickson, and Madison, Chase, Payne, Pierce, Reed, and Faith-Caroline Cormick; as well as many nephews and nieces that she loved very much. She was preceded in death by her father, Vernon, and her sister, Sheri.

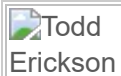
