



## Trevor Craig Moore

Trevor Craig Moore, 19, of Mansfield, WA passed away Sunday, August 11, 2024. He was born on February 6, 2005 in Brewster, WA.

Trevor attended Mansfield School for 14 years; preschool through senior year graduating in 2023. He then attended Walla Walla Community College working toward his Diesel Technology Associates and Certification in order to gain knowledge and come back to the family farm.

Trevor not only attended Mansfield School, he grew up IN the Mansfield School facility. The school gym, hallways, fields, classrooms, closets, training rooms, whirlpools, locker room, playgrounds, kitchen, and stage all watched Trevor grow from baby carrier to graduating senior. He was a three-sport athlete, playing every season, every year, from sixth grade on- but his passion was football: Chelan Youth Football, Mansfield/Waterville Kernels, and Waterville/Mansfield Shockers- he loved the intensity of the game, the camaraderie of the team, and the leadership required to hold it all together.

Trevor enjoyed being outside- On the water wakeboarding at Banks Lake and Conconully; relaxing at Jameson Lake with the Redneck Yacht Club; camping in the timber at Salmon Meadows, Liar's Cove, Pearrygin Lake, & Curlew; riding and jumping dirt bikes on backroads anywhere; hunting mule deer and coyotes on the plateau; chasing turkeys in Grand Coulee with his Papa; and stalking grouse on Funk Mountain- he appreciated spending time outdoors.

Most importantly he loved his RCM family farm. Picking rock, pulling rye, driving tractor, harvesting this year's crop, seeding next year's crop, repairing

machinery, performing maintenance- his devotion was to family and farm. Trevor was a good and loyal friend. He didn't know a stranger. Wherever he went, whatever he was doing, he made friends easily and held to them steadfastly. He was the life of every party, always making people smile with his antics. He was good natured and helped people around him to have a good time. But his heart was always with his family- he had strong, deep family ties- devoting himself to his sisters, his parents, his Nana, his Papa & Gram, his Papa Ric & Gramsy. His goal and dream were to be at home, farming side-by-side with his dad, close to the family he loved.

Trevor was preceded in death by his grandfather, Craig Moore. He is survived by his immediate family, Cory, Thera, Tiera and Caylin at the ranch and other family members too numerous to count or list and many, many friends he loved as family. We will never not remember him.
