



## Venera "Ven" M. Jordan

Venera "Ven" Jordan, 92, of Wenatchee passed away on Wednesday, March 9, 2011.

She was born to Anthony and Josephine DiSalvo, March 20, 1918 at East Rochester, New York, where she attended schools. After a few years of substitute secretarial positions, she attended a School of Cosmetology.
